

1. SCHEDULE

Final Registration and Parent Orientation will be Sunday June 26, 2016 @ 4:00pm. Attendance for a parent or guardian is required to go over last minute details, meet the Instructors and to learn any changes for this season.




There will be no sailing program on July 4th. We will have sailing program on Friday July 8th.

The program will begin Monday June 27^{TH} . The Junior Olympics are July 18^{th} & 19^{th} and all sailors, except for beginners, are strongly encouraged to register and race. The program will continue until Thursday, August 18^{TH} . Awards will be Friday night, August 19^{TH} .

2. FORMAT

The program is Monday through Thursday (except for Friday July 8th), 8:30am-3:30pm each day. However, 1st year sailors (Greenies) will be ending at 12:30 pm. (Times for greenies may change- we will inform you at final registration)

July 25-28 & August 1-4


Puddle Duck Ages - Sailor must be 6 or going into 1st grade


3. SIZE

The program will be limited to 65 sailors. Due to the individual instruction necessary, the Green Fleet will be limited to 12 per session. Limited facility size, the number of instructor's hired and the number of motorboats needed require that we limit the program. Our goal is to maintain a quality program for those children in the program.

4. ELIGIBILITY

All children must be 8 years old by the start of the program or entering the 3rd grade and not yet 18. (a birth certificate or school report card may be required)





5. PRE-REGISTRATION


There is a pre-registration process which is extremely important due to the proper hiring and oversight of the program. As indicated on the application, there will be a \$100.00 deposit due by May 20, 2016. This will allow for the sufficient time to address budgeting concerns. Please read the pre-registration policy written on the application form to avoid any potential misunderstandings. 
5.1. Required Paperwork

Included in this packet are the forms for "Statement of Parental Consent and Release from Liability", "Medical Consent", and "Sailor's Code of Conduct". 6. BOATS ARE MANDATORY (UNLESS A 420 CREW)

It has been determined that in the bests interests of everyone in the program, all sailors should have a boat to sail from day one. Participation without a boat is unfair to the child, the instructors and to the other sailors. Parents/guardians will have to purchase, lease, rent, or borrow boats in order to fulfill this requirement.





7. DIVISIONING

Due to different interests and abilities of each child, the Junior Sailing Committee has decided to separate the program into various distinct divisions. All sailors must pass a basic swim test (no life jacket) on the first day of program.

7.1. Beginner or Greenie Fleet


The Green fleet will focus on an introduction to sailing. emphasis on fundamentals, developing confidence around sailboats, understanding safety on the water and basic seamanship. 
7.2. Opti Silver Fleet

Will be for those sailors that have "graduated" from the Green Fleet. This fleet will emphasize participation rather than race results. Fun activities and basic drills will be incorporated into the class in order to foster a true a love sailing as an activity as well as a sport. Participation in Interclubs is optional; please speak with your Instructor if you wish your child to participate.

7.3. Opti Gold Fleet

This program is designed for the Opti sailor who enjoys some light competition. Participation in Interclubs is expected.





7.4. Opti Racing Fleet

This program is designed for sailors who truly enjoy competing and who will be racing in all bay area regattas.

7.5. Sunfish, Laser Radial, & 420 Fleets

These fleets are intended for older, more experienced sailors. Advanced racing techniques and strategies will be focused on as well as the concepts and techniques of double handed sailing. Participation in Interclubs is expected. Participation in all bay area regattas is strongly encouraged.


7.6. Changes to Divisions


These categories may change based on registration!

The instructional staff will decide, based upon performance levels, which division (with the exception of the Green Fleet) each sailor will participate in. Evaluations of all sailors will continually be done throughout the program to determine if they are capable of moving up a division, if they wish to do so. No child will be forced to move up to any division.

8. NOTES


- a) We will limit the program to 65 sailors. Green Fleet will be limited to 12 sailors
- b) If demand exceeds 65, priority will be given to members' children and existing non-member children in the program.






Siblings of existing non-members will have priority over new non-members. After May 20th, if there are still spots available, priority will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.

- c) There will be pre-registration. A \$100 deposit per registered sailor is required by May 20, 2016 to reserve a spot. The balance is due by June 19, 2016.
- d) Included in this packet are the forms for "Statement of Parental Consent and Release from Liability", "Medical Consent" and "Sailor's Code of Conduct". - e) Families with 3 or more children in the program can pay half of the required deposit.
- f) Registration after June 20TH will only be accepted if there are less than 65 sailors pre-registered and requires an additional \$50 late fee.
- g) Pre-registration fees will only be refunded if the spot reserved for your child is filled.
- h) All children registered MUST have their own boat, if not crewing in a 420. Parents/guardians will have to purchase, charter, or rent a boat.
- i) Green fleet sailors must have a bow bumper affixed to their boat at the start of program. The BBYRA has updated the guidelines








9. IMPORTANT DATES

Each Sailor will receive a T Shirt as part of the registration.




11. HOW TO REGISTER

Registration is once again on-line this year. After reading this packet, proceed to the calendar appointment for "Jr Sailing Registration" found on Sunday June 27, 2016.

Members log on to your account. Non-members will need to fill out the information form. Each child will need to be registered individually; there is no way to use contact information from one registration and apply it to another, so you will need to type all required information for each of your children.


<u>STEP 1</u>: On the calendar event, select the "REGISTER HERE" button off to the right.










STEP 2: Select which fleet is applicable for your sailor.

















Once you "Complete Registration", you will arrive on the payment page. At this point, your registration has already been saved.


① Your registration has been saved. Please select your payment options below.

There is a \$100 deposit required to lock in your registration. You may use the web site to submit payment with a credit card, or you can "Cancel Payment" and submit a \$100 deposit check before the May 15 deadline.





If you pay by credit card, be sure to check the authorization checkbox. You are also welcome to change the \$100.00 amount to any desired amount to pay more than the deposit at the time of registration by changing the value in the red box labeled "Total Selected for Payment".



Note that for Members of IHYC, your balance will be transferred to your online account so that you can make subsequent payments towards your balance online as well.

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
